DESCRIPTION: The purpose of this monetary award is to promote outstanding musical performance and further education opportunities for aspiring students

ELIGIBILITY:

A current university applicant must already be enrolled as a music major or minor. A high school senior whose college application to study music is already in process. The first eight applicants will be accepted.

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS:

Two solo works are required, one from the Baroque or Classical eras and one from Romantic or Modern eras. Memorization of one of the compositions is required. Most winners memorize both works. Each audition will be twenty (20) minutes in duration. If the music requires an accompanist, the applicant must furnish one.

Following the applicant's musical performance, there may be a brief oral theory examination which may include the playing/singing of scales. The student may also be asked to demonstrate knowledge of music theory and sight-reading ability.

APPLICATION SUBMISSION:

Your music must be submitted electronically in PDF file format. The PDF must accompany the application and sent via email to the address provided. No exceptions. Please ensure that the music is legible, and the measures are numbered. The \$20 application fee must be paid online at the time of submission as well.

The application must include three signatures: 1. Applicant. 2. Private instructor of the applicant. 3. Parent/Guardian (if applicant is under 18 years of age). A photocopy of the applicant's driver's license or government issued passport must accompany the application.

ADJUDICATORS:

A panel of qualified musicians will judge your performance. Comments and suggestions will be provided to each applicant following the audition.

MONETARY AWARD: The Dora Dawson Monetary Award ranges from \$250 to \$1000. The award amount will depend upon musical excellence at the audition. The award winner will perform in concert Sunday March 8, 2026, at 3:00 PM and will receive the monetary award at this time.

Award winners may not re-audition the following year.
