ELIGIBILITY:

Each applicant must be enrolled in a Michigan college or university and currently enrolled in a school of music as a music major, with piano as the principal performance instrument. (Must be majoring in piano). The first five applicants will be accepted.

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS:

<u>Two solo works are required</u>, one from the Baroque era or from the Classical era and one from either the Romantic or Modern eras. <u>Memorization of the compositions is required</u>. A piano selection will be given to the applicant at the time of the audition for the purpose of sight-reading. Recorded auditions are not accepted. Thirty minutes will be provided for the audition.

APPLICATION SUBMISSION:

Your music must be submitted electronically in PDF file format. The PDF must accompany the application and sent via email to the address provided. No exceptions. Please ensure that the music is legible, and the measures are numbered. The \$20 application fee must be paid online at the time of submission as well.

The application must include two signatures: 1. Applicant 2. Private instructor of the applicant. A photocopy of the applicant's driver's license or government issued passport must accompany the application.

ADJUDICATORS:

A panel of qualified musicians will judge your performance. Comments and suggestions will be provided to each applicant following the audition.

MONETARY AWARD: The Rosamond P. Haeberle Piano Monetary Award will be up to \$5,000.00. Musical excellence will be rewarded. The winner will perform at a concert on Sunday, March 8, 2026, at 3:00PM, and receive the monetary award at this time.

- All original music written for piano
- No arrangements/transcriptions
- All music to be memorized
- Performance of two selections from the three eras listed below
- Baroque era. J.S. Bach; a major work, such as a Prelude and Fugue from *The Well-Tempered Clavier*, or a Toccata; one or more movements may be selected from the *Partitas*, *French* and *English Suites*, or *The Italian Concerto*.
- 2 Classical era. The first movement of a sonata by Haydn, Mozart, Schubert, or Beethoven. (Complete sonatas may be performed in concert.)
- Romantic or Modern eras One selection of your own choice from the 19th or 20th century, such as A. B. or C.
 - A. A major composition from the romantic period, such as a Chopin *Ballade* or a Brahms *Rhapsody*.
 - B. An etude of virtuosity. Suggested composers: Chopin, Liszt, Debussy, Rachmaninoff, Scriabin, Perle, Thomson, Bartok, Szymanowski, Ligeti, Rorem, Edward MacDowell.
 - C. A significant work of a published composer from the United States of America.
